Duration of the course: Begin: October 8, 2021 – July 30, 2022

Time for the lectures: Almost each Friday 4 pm – 9 pm and Saturday 10 am – 5/6 pm during the year. The lesson times are fixed in the schedule. The schedule will be sent on request.

Lectures in German and English:

All lectures are onsite, the Trainer is German, speaks the two languages. All lectures are in the course room. We understand that it is not easy or possible for everyone to come to the Training Centre. If you are abroad or are unable, or unwilling to come to the Training Centre due to health risks or quarantine requirements, you may join live stream of the lectures that will be made available. Please note that joining the lectures online is not a choice but an option when this is absolutely necessary.

What happens, when you cannot come during the summertime next year?

If restrictions resulting from corona pandemic, negatively affect or hinder students in completing their requirements, these restrictions will be compensated by appropriate deadline extensions. Any decisions pertaining to deadline extensions will be made by those responsible, upon request of the student. In this context, the Association Montessori Internationale (AMI) also state that it is possible to approve extension deadlines beyond the maximum extensions specified in the examination regulations, as long as this is deemed necessary to compensate for any disadvantage that has arisen as the result of the corona pandemic.

The Supervised Practice of 140 hours serves the own experience with the Montessori material.

Students are expected to complete Observation of children of 90 hours and Teaching Practice with children of 80 hours in a Montessori Kindergarten. Requirements are set under supervision of AMI Trainer. The place and the time must be organized independently by the student.
